About The Split-level Home Style

Unlike the single level ranch bungalow, split-level homes feature a more innovative design where the floor levels are staggered, creating two levels of living space in part of the home. Typically, the front entry opens into the main level, which is halfway between the upper and lower floors. The main level often features common living areas, including a living room, dining room, kitchen, and deck off the back.

There are two half staircases, one running upward to the bedroom level and one going downward to a basement level, which is usually finished off as a family room. The basement level often features a laundry room, a garage, and is level with the driveway.
