


Inside, Summerhouse offers a distinguished array of home layouts, including garden-level townhomes, premium residences and panoramic penthouses,












KITCHEN/LIVING



The village offers a range of shops and services, including a pharmacy, grocery store, cafés and a delightful sewing studio and workshop.





A UNIQUE PARTNERSHIP



In a commitment to preserve one of the area's most iconic greenspaces, Aryze made a donation to formally downzone the Abkhazi Garden property, contributing to its preservation for generations to come. This initiative not only secured the enduring protection of this beloved landmark, but also created the opportunity for new homes in the beloved Gonzales neighbourhood in the form of Summerhouse.

The name Summerhouse pays homage to this legacy, inspired by the very first structure built on the Abkhazi Garden property in 1946.
